Subtracting Near Multiples of 10

The children have been learning to subtract near multiples of 10 (e.g. $54 - 19 =$) by subtracting 20 instead of 19 and then adjusting by adding 1. Use the dartboard overleaf and play 501. Each player starts with 501. Throw a dart (you may wish to use real darts if you have them or maybe have the board on a table and roll a dice to see where it lands). Subtract the number you throw from 501 mentally and keep a running total.

- **ful**, **ly** and **tion** can normally be added to words with no alteration, except words ending in **y** which change to an **i**
- words ending in **t**, drop the **t** before adding **tion**.
- before adding **ive**, **ic** or **ist**, drop the final **e** or **y** before adding suffix
