Homework is designed to reinforce skills learned and practised in school the previous week. Please let me know if your child is having difficulty with homework or if it is causing anxiety for any reason. It is advisable to look at your child's numeracy homework with them on the Monday, in case they need further support back at school on the Tuesday or Wednesday in our homework club. In addition to learning spellings, the children will be expected to use these in well punctuated sentences. Each week there will continue to be a particular grammar focus. The children have been given a bookmark which has helpful questions you can ask, when hearing them read. This will encourage their progress with
