# **Traffic**

It has been brought to my attention that parents are not always following the school's traffic code of conduct. Please can I remind you of the following to ensure the safety of our children:

Parking in the Village Hall car park and walking up Church Lane is strongly advised. Please do not park in front of the Village Hall or in front of the houses directly outside (this is private property). There is plenty of space at the rear of the Village Hall.

Cars are advised to be clear of Church Lane by 3.25pm therefore allowing the Pilton bus to drive away from the school without obstruction.

Do not park at the top of the lane, at the narrow parts of the lane or on the corner at the top of Church Lane by the car park as it is the turning place for vehicles.

Do not park in the 'Disabled Parking' area unless you have a legitimate badge. Please inform the school office if this is the case.

Vehicles driving **down** Church Lane have priority.

Park considerately without blocking driveways, mounting pavements or verges and **do not use driveways to turn**.


