Daniel B took on the role of the little girl in the story 'A Child's Garden' by Michael Foreman and the rest of the class asked him questions, which he answered in role. I was so impressed by the thoughtful approach and the development of inference and deduction skills – well done Year 6!

## TIME? TABLE? FOCK!TAR?

When it comes to times tables, speed AND accuracy are important – the more facts your child remembers, the easier it is for them to do harder calculations.

Times Table Rock Stars is a fun and challenging programme designed to help students master their times tables. The children play times tables games as a rock star on various stages, collect coins for doing so and can spend those 'coins' to upgrade their rock star status. They can challenge themselves this way in order to improve their tables knowledge, but they can also compete with others using the site. We have purchased the subscription for all children in the school to enjoy!

Children from Year 1\* upwards will each be given a log-on in the coming weeks. (\*Year 1 will be issued a log-on later in the year when multiplication has been explored in more depth). The class teachers can assign tables and tailor them to each child – let them know if you wish the level of challenge to be adjusted.
