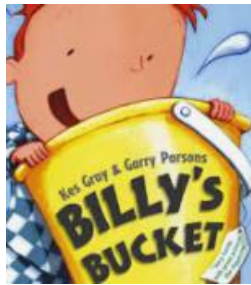


Year 2 - Summer Term Curriculum 2021

MATHS: Number facts and bonds, value of numbers using Th H T O to partition and calculate and reason to solve calculations in different ways. Times tables 2, 5, 10 and 3.

ENGLISH: we will be reading a variety of books that link with Seaside and school values. We continue with Julia Donaldson and start Billy's Bucket. Some key features to focus on: punctuation (using finger spaces, capital letters, full stops, speech marks, question marks), alternative spelling rules, writing stories with description and information texts based on topics. Handwriting as cursive. Phonics/spelling - teaching Phase 4/5 with a focus on applying High Frequency Words into written learning and adding prefix and suffix and plural rules. Reading independently and together, at every opportunity!
