




# Weekly Newsletter

### Healthy Lifestyles Week

What a wonderful week it has been! The children really enjoyed the 'Skip to be fit' day and focussed on beating their personal bests. I have purchased some of the skipping ropes for the children to use at playtimes and as part of their PE lessons and I look forward to seeing their skipping skills develop. ### **One of our fabulous Year 6 girls would like to share the following with you:**

Recently I wanted to know more about what happened the day my dad died and heard about how the Air Ambulance helped on that day.

Over the next year I want to raise £2500 for Dorset and Somerset Air Ambulance, because this is approximately how much it costs for one call out.

The Air Ambulance is totally reliant on donations – it doesn't receive any help from the government.

We are going to be fund-raising by running 5000 miles over a year. Eleven of us are running as part of the challenge: Me, Isaac and Mum; Dad's brothers Tim and Joe, my Uncle Sam and Auntie Ceriss and 4 of my cousins Joe, Owain, Noah and Jack. We started this on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan and plan to finish on the 25<sup>th</sup> Jan 2019 – which will be exactly 10 years since they saved Isaac's life. Together we need to run more than 96 miles per week – hopefully we can do some more Golden Miles in school as I can count them towards our total!
