#### **Mental Health Support**

There's a Mental Health Support service on offer in Somerset. The service is offered by Young Somerset (previously Somerset Rural Youth Project) offering support to young people aged 8-19 with their mental health. The support can be at home, school, in a GP surgery or at the organisation's Wellbeing Room. You can get help with stress management, anxiety, OCD, low mood or panic. 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#### Year 6 Life Skills Visit

#### Cromebooks

Exciting tech news - last week we had 30 high-end Acer Flip Chromebooks delivered and installed to support teaching and learning in all classes across the school. We went for Acer Flip Chromebooks as they have the important functionality of having a keyboard, with the additional ability to 'flip over' to become a tablet. The Chromebooks will prove an invaluable tool within school, not least as the children will now have the use of a variety of devices, not just having a knowledge of, and skill in using, one device or operating system. We now have Windows-based desktop and laptop computers, android tablets, ipads and Chromebooks. A huge, huge thank you to the FWPS for funding the Chromebooks and for all the incredibly hard work that they do in raising money to provide such important and invaluable experiences for the children of the school.
