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Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend our Harvest Festival. I am sure that you will agree that our Year 6 children led the service brilliantly and articulated some important messages.

This week I visited classes with Mr Wheat (as Maths Lead) to monitor the teaching and learning of Maths. One of our whole school developments this year is to ensure that we are 'deepening' children's understanding of number and mathematical concepts. In the younger classes we are beginning to embed something called 'bar-modelling' and had some training on this last week. We are also focusing on using concrete apparatus and visual representations to ensure that children are not just 'number crunching' but actually understanding why things happen with number and explaining their reasoning. The primary and secondary curriculum has a much sharper focus on reasoning and problem-solving.
