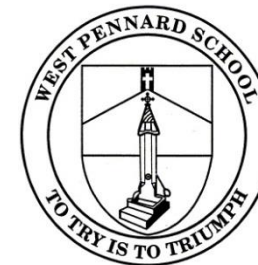


West Pennard Church of England Primary School
